

Blackjack Dealer Training Program

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I get accepted to attend the Blackjack Dealer Training Program?

You must pass a timed basic math test and an interview to be accepted.

What is the cost of the tuition?

The cost of tuition for the Blackjack Dealer Training Program is \$300.00. The tuition is payable in two payments of \$150.00 each (payments must be made by Cashier's Check or Money Order). Payments are due the first and third Monday of the training session.

What is the class schedule?

Classes are Monday through Thursday for nine weeks.

What are the class times?

Class times vary for different reasons. Class times may be any of the following: 9:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m., 2:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. or from 6:00 p.m. -9:00 p.m.

Will I get a job as a Dealer at Northern Quest Resort & Casino when I complete the class?

If you successfully complete the Blackjack Dealer Training Program you will be eligible to audition for a job at Northern Quest Resort & Casino (most openings are usually part time or on call to start out). You will also be prepared to deal anywhere else that has table games.

How do I get a gaming license and how much does it cost?

Gaming licensing will be your responsibility if a casino hires you. The cost varies from \$245.00 to \$304.00 in the state of Washington.

What games will I learn at the school?

If selected to attend our training program, you will be trained to deal Blackjack, Spanish 21, Three Card Poker, Pai-gow Poker and Ultimate Texas Hold'em.

What are some of the physical demands required to be a Blackjack Dealer

1. Constantly requires the ability to give and receive detailed information through verbal communication.
2. Constantly requires working with fingers rather than the whole hand or arm.
3. Constantly requires repetitive movement of the wrists, hands and/or fingers.
4. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, and the ability to adjust focus.
