Insurance:

For *medical services*, the clinic is currently accepting: First Choice (Group Health PPO), Asuris, Interwest (PHCO), Washington Medicaid, Medicare, Premera, Molina, Sterling, Tricare, Uniform Medical and Contract Health (Kalispel Tribe Social Services). This includes physical therapy and chiropractic services, excluding Medicaid for chiropractic services. Various insurance plans will affect your coverage. Please contact your insurance company if you have questions regarding coverage for specific medical services.

For *dental services*, the clinic is currently accepting: Washington Delta Dental, United Concordia, Metlife Dental, Washington Medicaid, Sterling and Contract Health (Kalispel Tribe Social Services).

PAYMENT

Camas Center Medical and Dental Services does not currently offer services at reduced rates for community members with limited income. Payment, including insurance copayment, is expected at the time of service. If you have health insurance coverage please bring your health insurance card with you to your appointment in order to facilitate billing.

- ◆ Teen Room (including a 13-computer lab)
- ◆ Deli (full kitchen)
- ◆ Fitness Center (state of the art fitness equipment, locker rooms, wet/dry sauna, climbing wall, gymnasium)
- ◆ Aquatic Area (4 lane lap pool, water slide, children's pools, hot tub)
- ◆ Meeting Rooms– attached to full kitchen

Frequently asked Questions

Who may use the clinic?

The clinic is open to everyone, including both tribal members and non-tribal community members.

Do I need a membership to the Camas Fitness Center to use the clinic?

No. You do not need any sort of membership.

Will my insurance cover the services provided?

The clinic will bill Medicare, Medicaid and/or other health insurance companies as appropriate. We will be contracted as a Preferred Provider with some of the major insurance carriers and networks in the service area. Please contact your insurance company if you have questions about what is covered by your insurance plan.

Do I need an appointment?

Yes. We ask that you please call in advance before coming to the clinic, so that we can be best prepared for providing you quality health care services.

What if I want to be a “walk-in” patient?

If you need to see a health care provider on the same day we will make every effort to accommodate you on the schedule, but please realize that you still must make an appointment and availability is limited.

Do you have an emergency room?

No. There is not an emergency room. The clinic is not an urgent care facility. If you or someone you know has a potentially life threatening condition please call 911.
